Crisis System Calls Updates (Major recent changes?)

BHR (Holly Nemec)

- Seen a 1% increase in calls which is up 55% from March – lots of the calls are related to joblessness and homelessness
- Seen a 4% increase in suicide hotline calls.

Ozark Center (Debbie Fitzgerald)

- Increase in calls
- Hailee Bradshaw continues to have lots of referrals (2nd highest amongst CMHLs last month)
- ER volume down
- Seen an increase in student binge drinking
- Since Oct 1 have seen 100 clients
