- Seen a 1% increase in calls which is up 55% from March lots of the calls are related to joblessness and homelessness
- Seen a 4% increase in suicide hotline calls.

## Ozark Center (Debbie Fitzgerald)

- Increase in calls
- Hailee Bradshaw continues to have lots of referrals (2<sup>nd</sup> highest amongst CMHLs last month)
- ER volume down
- Seen an increase in student binge drinking
- Since Oct 1 have seen 100 clients
